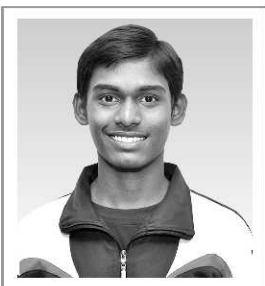

Testimony of Paramesh

Parmesh is the Chief Instructor at Rock climbing school Bhongir & Transcend Adventure Pvt Ltd. He's a 37 year-old practicing advocate in Hyderabad, and having an experience of 13 years mountaineering. He trained the swaeroes at the Rock climbing school, Bhongir for five days, and led them to Mt. Renock in November 2013. He has proved to be a reliable guide and trustworthy person, who escorted the swaeroes to Mt. Renock successfully and brought them back safe. He shares his experiences with the readers thus ...

These kids surprised everyone there. The Course Director of HMI expressed his awe when he saw them saying, "What, you brought kids!!"

I then replied him, "They have sufficient stamina, energy, and courage to accomplish the task. They have been tested and found to be fit physically and mentally".

The age limit to go on this Mountaineering training is in fact, 18 years and above. But we had obtained special permission to take our SWAEROES who are all between 14 and 17 years. This bewildered the five instructors of HMI, who were accompanying the SWAEROS. Then I entered into an agreement with the Course Director Sri. Roshan Ghatraj stating "If our girls and guys failed to perform to your expectation till Bakhim, which is the first camp, we could be sent back". I made the children understand this point, and we decided to overcome the issue step by step, creating a prompt impression upon the instructors there. None of the twenty that were taken for the task was weak. Their resolve to perform increased my confidence.

Ms. Surekha, Physical Education Teacher of Tadkol school was of enormous help too. She's an expert wrestler, and a fighter against the odds. She led the squad from the front. I remained behind to survey and monitor the march. It's the toughest trek in Asia. These kids climbed 4000ft in just six hours apart from 14km trek, which is

tough even for **adults** to accomplish. I myself took to do it in **6 and half** hours at **25** years of age! It's in fact, a record according to me. All these children reached the Base Camp which is **14,600ft** high, despite severe twinge by night. They used to scream with pains and massage one another with the balms we carried. This was mainly due to the 20kg baggage that had to be carried at that altitude. Their team spirit has to be appreciated for their sprightly sallies and sportive attitude. Believe me, the forces there, were really amazed to see the incredible energy and audacity of these children.

These girls and guys somehow have a natural ability, talent, endurance and energy endowed in them. This perhaps, they inherit from the virility of their parents or could be due to regular exercising and participation in sports and games in their schools. Their physical fitness and immunity to cold is matchless. I'm surprised even at their courage! They are truly fearless and ready to embark upon any odd situation without wavering. I was neither frustrated nor disappointed even once with their performance. There wasn't a single situation when I scolded or chided them. My confidence and trust increased as we kept ascending rock after rock.

In fact, we provided training in Rock Climbing at Rock climbing school Bhongir along with other important elements before taking them to Mountaineering. With this they were able to fulfill the requirements of the HMI, and gain consent. What I understand from this trip is that the **SWAEROES need guidance and support**. Once they have this, **they are capable of creating records and history!!!**

Mohan Prasad, a fourteen year-old student astounded everyone, being tender in age as well as in physique. I surmise that he's the youngest **that has successfully completed such a difficult training and scaled** such a height in India. None expected him to go that height. He proved everyone wrong.

Once we touched the glacier region, it was like a heaven. It was like a desert covered with snow all around. But our SWAEROES waded fumbling and rising, although with great difficulty of facing -30°C temperature at nights.

On reaching our target, the Mt. Renock peak, their elation was indescribable. They kept dancing and singing with shouts of success! I'm sure **Dr. R S Praveen Kumar** was able to hear them utter his name with cheer. Then they pitched the **four** flags (Indian National Flag, Society Flag, **Transcend Adventures** and SWAEROES flags) in ground. It took the kids just **Four hours and twenty minutes** only to summit the target, **undoubtedly, is a record and a history created by our SWAEROES!!! It's indeed, a stunning feat.**

My journey with these young SWAEROES is a memorable experience. The trip would add bliss to my solitude heart when in pensive mood.

I hope and pray that they also ascend Mt. Everest one day and hoist SWAEROES flag.

THEY TREAD THUS

Secretary had issued a circular asking every school to select two students each to undergo Rock Climbing training at Rock Climbing School, Bhongir. About **120** students reported to be trained for five days in batches. Eventually ten girls and ten boys were chosen to go on a great adventure, **OP-EVEREST**. The team consisted of 20 SWAEROES, Mr. Parmesh Kumar (Chief Instructor), Mr. Anil Kumar (Instructor), and me, Ms. B. Surekha (PET).

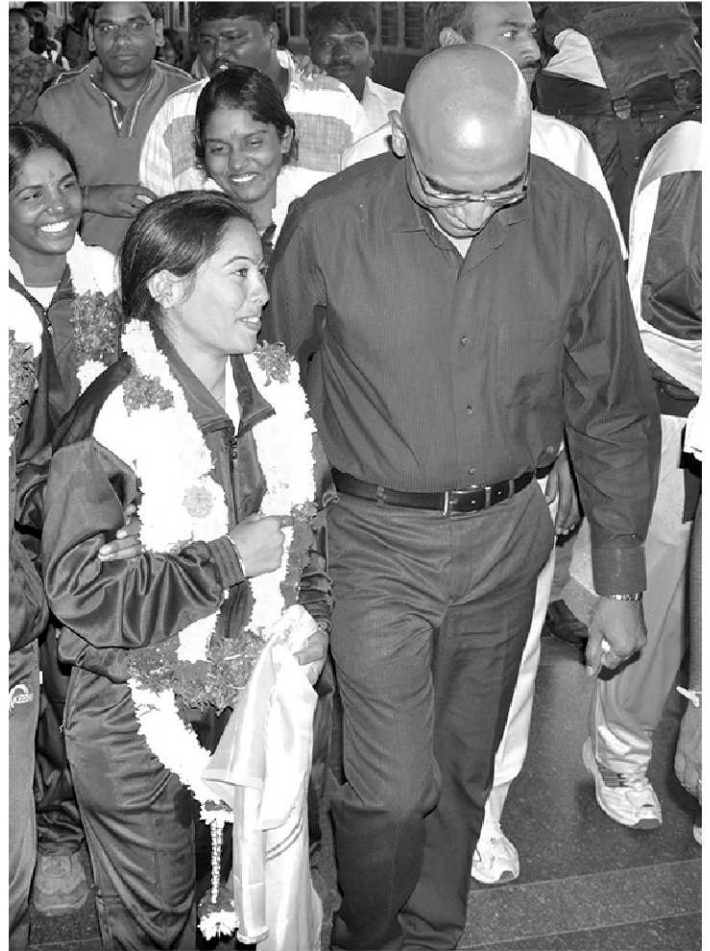
We twenty three boarded a train for New Jalpaiguri on 25th October 2013 and reached the place on 27th, a journey of **three** tedious days as the regular route took a different turn due to unknown reasons.

We took a taxi from the railway station and reported at HMI (Himalayan Mountaineering Institute) by 19.30 hours on 27th. HMI was established in 1954 under the guidance of Tenzing Norgay, the first hero to conquer Mt. Everest. We are the youngest team to be entered in the records of HMI. We rested there for two days besides some physical training and moved towards Yakshum town. We spent that night there and left for **Bakhim at 7.00** am which is about 9000 ft high, carrying 20 kg of **rucksack** (baggage) crossing four **suspension bridges build with iron ropes**. We all reached Bakhim by 1 pm, ascending the height in six hours. This quick journey on foot created a better impression upon the four HMI **instructors** that accompanied us. We were further trained there for two days for acclimatization. We proved ourselves eligible at this point and moved for **Dzongri** which lay at a height of **13,000** ft height. The team moved for Dzongri at 7:00 am with the rucksack over our shoulders. We could reach the spot by 2.00 pm to rest at the HMI guest house.

After spending one night at Dzongri the team again with the rucksack over our shoulders left for HMI Base camp which lay at a height of 14,600 ft and reached by 2.15 pm, and the weather at -30 degree Celsius. The journey seemed tougher in the sense that the rocks lay steep and we had to climb them vertically. The path move from one hill to another is too narrow for two to move at a time. One could see a big river flowing full 1000 ft below in a valley – a most dangerous mount! It was a frightful situation. But we did it with the help of oral guidance.

Here at the Base Camp, we were given 'Glacier training' for five days. It was extremely cold. Every water drop becomes lump there. Glacier training is a preparation to move on ice-craft and snow-craft. It was so tough that seven of SWAEROES remained back at the Base Camp itself and the rest was ready to walk through the snow to conquer Mt. Renock, our target.

Mt. Renock lay at a height of 17,000 ft and it normally **takes 4 to 5 hours to scale from HMI Base camp**. With suitable instructions and fitting training, the thirteen Swaeroes along with the instructors left for Renock peak at **7:00** in the morning. The snow is like salt particles there. It's like walking through sand – a tough waist-deep wading in

the snow! The moving in the ice-blogs where our feet went in knee-deep was fun and tougher. But the sight itself was quite pleasant. This tramp took us just four hour and twenty minutes only, which apparently is a record.

The sight of Mt. Renock was boundless jubilation on 10th November 2013. We couldn't believe ourselves. We conquered it. It seemed as though we were on top of the world! The moment we reached the peak, we pitched the four flags – national, society, Transcend Adventures and Swaeroes. Then unable to control our joy, we yelled the name of Secretary which reverberated in the mountains.

The return to HMI on 13th November was quite easy. We were greeted by our Secretary and Sri Shekhar Babu on 15th at the HMI. Their presence added solid energy that was lost in the trek. Our Secretary stayed back that night at the HMI to be the Chief Guest of the '**Graduation Ceremony**' on 16th. We received our Certificates issued by the HMI through his hands. It would all remain as a life-long memorable incident.

On our arrival to Secunderabad, we were given a **stupendous reception on par with celebrities!**

the Big Man**

Congratulating you, Mohan Prasad, on your successful completion of the Rock Climbing 2nd stage, I am privileged to come face to face to interview U.

Mohan! Thank you Glory akka... proceed.

Glory: By the way, when did u join our APSWREI Society?

Mohan: I was admitted into 5th class in COE, VSP in 2009.

Glory: Mohan, tell about your beautiful family ?

Mohan: I am from Kovvada in Vizianagaram Dist. with a poor family background. Demudu, my father, is an agricultural laborer and my mother Jaya is a housemaid. Nagamani, my sister is studying Ist MPC in APR Bheemili, Visakhapatnam.

Glory: How were u selected for the mountaineering camp?

Dear sister, our Principal Secretary, Mr. Raymond Peter, IAS, and our beloved Secretary, Dr. R.S. Praveen Kumar, IPS arranged the preliminary training to the school level selected candidates at Bhongiri in Nalgonda Dist., On the basis of my performance, I was recommended for the Mount Everest Mountaineering Camp.

Glory: Can u share some of your experiences?

Mohan: Yeah, sure, with pleasure. In Bhongiri, we underwent a Spl. Training for 5 days in mountaineering. There they selected 20 members for Darjeeling Camp. wherein vigorous training was given in snow craft, ice craft and rock craft in glaciers.

Glory: Mohan! How is this mountaineering helpful to you in your life?

Mohan: A very good question posed by you Glory akka. It helps to build confidence, develops hardworking nature and strengthens our planning and various skills, both mental and physical.

Glory: Mohan, were you ever afraid that something would endanger your life in this mountaineering?

Mohan: No, never...My long cherished goal of playing with snow has given me an immense satisfaction.

Glory: How is your parents' support?

Mohan: Though my parents are illiterate and innocent when I informed about my selection, they just patted me with the 2 words ; 'go ahead which work as vitamins'

Glory: How did you feel when our Secretary announced amidst your parents & august gathering on 4th December about your selection to Norway by flight for a special training in mountaineering ?

Mohan: (Tears of joy seen in his eyes) Firstly, I feel proud of being a SWAERO under the dynamic leadership of Dr. R. S. Praveen Kumar who always affectionately calls me **BIG MAN**.

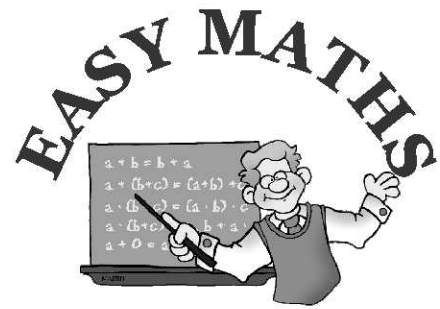

He took his 13 years of rich experience back to Delhi and started a Designer store of his own called The Design Verandah. As you can see, designers can make the shoddiest look stylish, recreate and revamp and scorch the ramp with their unique creations! Nishit is one such designer who specializes in Indian Ethnic with 'no nonsense cuts'.

In his interview Nishit speaks up candidly about fashion, prospects and taboos too.

Is fashion as glamorous and rosy as it appears to be?

Certainly not, it's a lot of sweat, toil and tremendous hard work! I am not really all praises for this line...as there is much more for people to know before entering this line.

That's the common man's perception; frankly the subjects that lured me even more into this were elements of design, principles of design and color theory. In fact clothes cutting and stitching....sorry...did not even think I'd be doing it someday!

Does the four year course emphasise more on technicalities of fashion or creativity?

Both. It's a very educative, informative and interesting programme.

What's the most sought-after course in fashion career studies?

Popularity wise it's designing—either designing with a domestic brand like pantaloons, or being a designer in an export house

or /and designing for your own label. But, earning wise its merchandising.

Could you tell us about emerging trends in fashion?

For the last few years merchandising is being explored as a very lucrative field. It is all about picking up the right stock at the right place for the right price. These are the key people. Especially in all the retail outlets their need is more. Vision merchandising has also picked up in a big way. All the advertisements and banners speak about this. Students are given a practical training which is a part of their practical training. NIFT pedagogy is hands on activities. Seventy percent of the curriculum is taught outside the classroom like hands on activity and only thirty percent is inside the class.

What is the most preferred branch in NIFT?

Undoubtedly it is fashion designing as they are the divas! It is not all about glamour, ramp, style and showbiz but it is creativity unleashed! One has to have abundant originality to survive here.

Do you have any gospel truth to share with the aspiring designers?

1. Possessive pronouns like **OURS** and **THEIRS** do not have an `apostrophe before the "s". You only use an apostrophe for the possessive form of nouns, such as **Tom's** or **Children's**.

Sheela's hair is longer than **your's** (incorrect)

You donot use a possessive pronoun with the personal pronoun "it". Possessive pronouns refer back to people, not to animals or things.

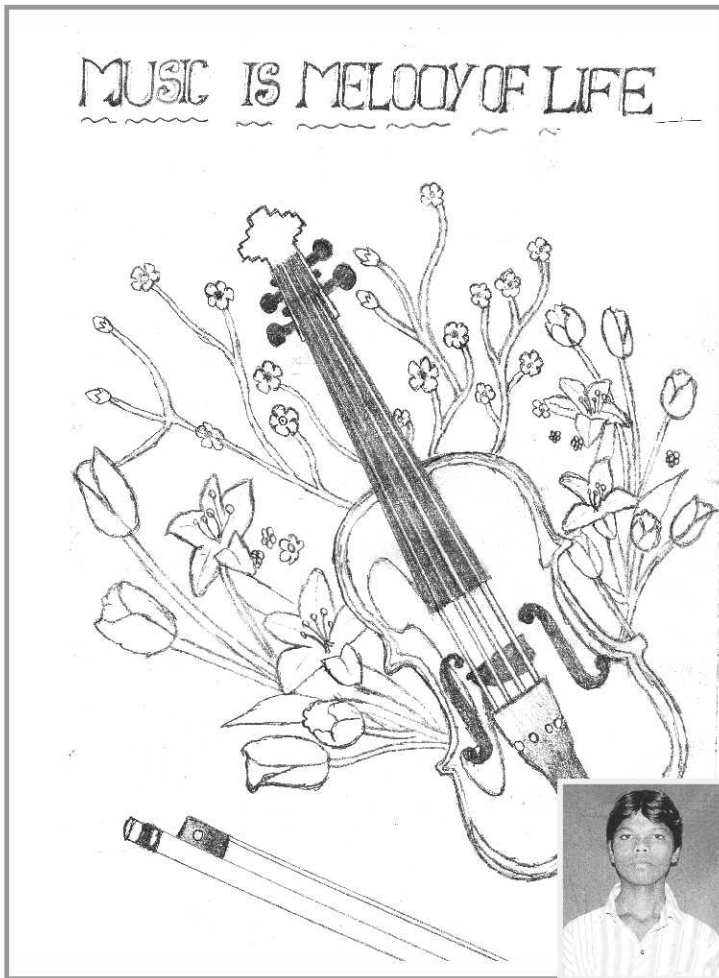

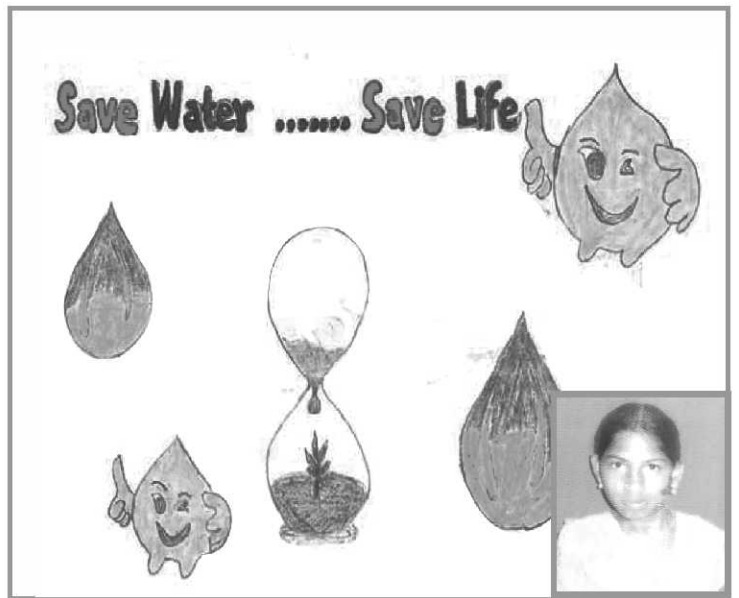
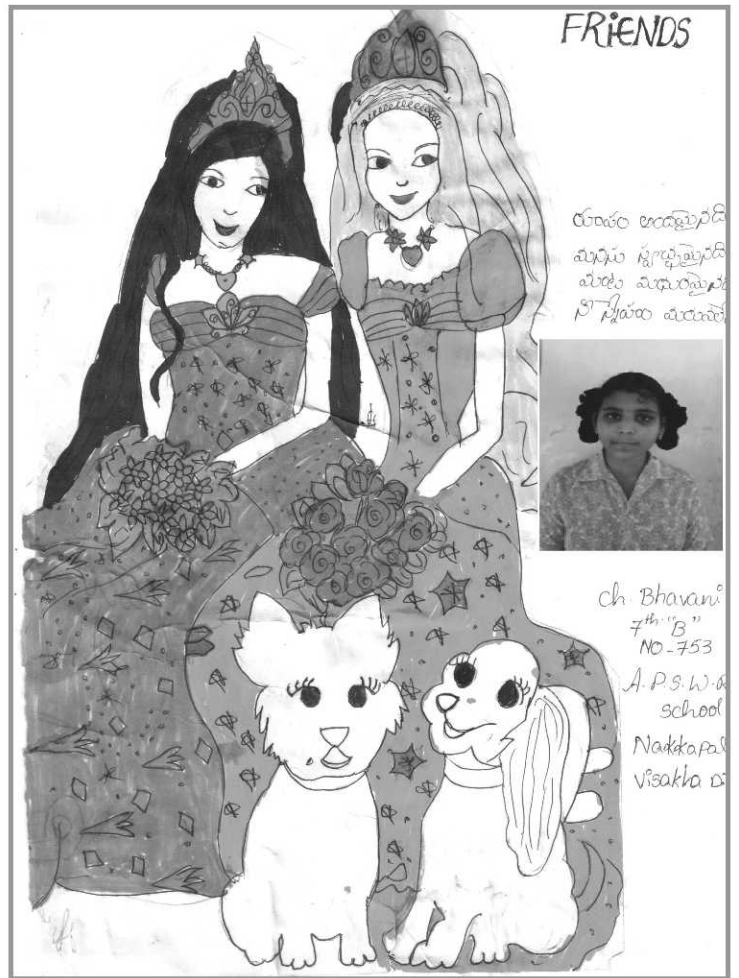
